

In addition to the taped services that are being offered, I would like to propose a live call next week for anyone who would like to join a "drop-in" video call to hear a scripture and prayer, a musical selection and to be able to see the others from St. Andrew's who join the call. The goal is to connect in a way in which we might finally, after two months, actually "see" one another by way of a video call.

I would propose Wednesday, May 20 at 11:00 AM for our Drop-In Video call. We will be using a Zoom link which some of you have used and others have not. Below is a link which when you click on the link will connect you to a secure video call on your computer/phone or iPad. Once on the call the screen will enable you to see the others who have joined the call as well. If you would like to practice using Zoom prior to our call on Wednesday, give me a call and I will be happy to work with you to get you comfortable using Zoom.

The success of such a call might enable us in the coming weeks to try something similar on Sunday mornings during which we might be able to provide a live worship service and view it from our computer screens from the comfort of our own homes. All that is required is to click the meeting link (or copy and paste it into your web browser) around 11:00 AM on Wednesday, May 20, 2020. I suspect the call will last approximately 30 minutes.
