You are welcome to join the virtual book club of God Walk by Mark Buchanan.

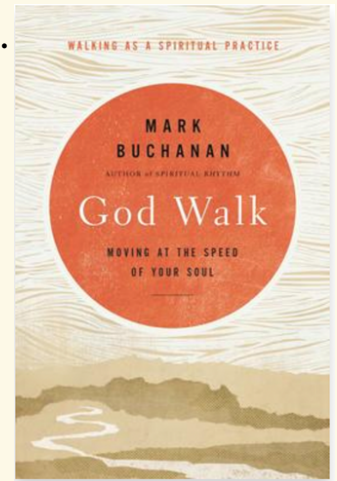
When: Every Wednesday until June 1st, 7:00pm - 8:00pm
